

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 434

Date: May 11, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Increases the mandatory allocation of revenues to the public school system from 15% to 25%

[Note: Mr. Jones urges that this amendment is necessary because the population base continues to expand, as does the student population. The public expects the Public School System to produce a qualified and competent local workforce.]
