It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that judges in the Commonwealth Superior Court and the Commonwealth Supreme Court shall be appointed by the Governor and serve an initial term of six years. Thereafter, each judge would stand for election, on a non-partisan basis, and the question put to the people would be whether this judge should be retained for a twelve-year term.
