It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides the five-year retirement credit to persons who were employed by the government on October 1, 1980, thus extending the five year credit back to 1980 retroactively.

Provides that persons retired from the government may be reemployed for up to two years without losing their retirement benefits.
