## Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -192-

Delegate Proposal No. 100

Date: May 13, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that if the Legislature fails to act by the end of the second regular session (of 30 days, beginning after July) on the proposed annual balanced budget submitted by the Governor, that budget shall be deemed to be approved and the Governor may sign it into law as if the Legislature had acted to approve it.
