Delegate Proposal No. 102

Date: May 13, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that no person convicted of a felony in the CNMI or in any area under the jurisdiction of the United States is eligible to hold office in the House or Senate unless a full pardon has been granted.
