

Delegate Proposal No. 124

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, may appoint special judges to serve in either the Supreme Court or the Superior Court.

This power can be exercised regardless of whether the Chief Justice agrees with the appointments. There are no constitutionally required qualifications for special judges.
