Delegate Proposal No. 129

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes the present budget ceiling on the Legislature of \$2.8 million.

Provides that the budget ceiling set by the Legislature may be changed annually by a composite price index prepared by the Director of Commerce and Labor.

Any budget ceiling set by the Legislature for itself does <u>not</u> include: salaries of members, benefits for members, housing allowances, inter-island travel, and dues to regional and international organizations.

Deletes the present limit of \$700,000 on obligations and expenditures during an election year.

Provides that the limit is 25% of the annual appropriation, and does <u>not</u> include anything not included in the budget ceiling.
