

Delegate Proposal No. 130

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes the current provision that the ceiling on the Legislative budget be divided equally between the House and the Senate.

Provides that each member of the Legislature gets a minimum allotment of \$100,000; and each member of the majority gets a minimum allotment of \$200,000. These allotments are for the operations and activities of the member's individual offices.
