Delegate Proposal No. 132

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the definition of the duties of the Legislative Bureau to remove the limitation to support for legislative sessions and committee meetings.

Provides that the Legislative Bureau may assist the Legislature in any of its duties and responsibilities, including community activities, international trips, personal staff responsibilities, and other duties.
