Delegate Proposal No. 133

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:


Deletes the ceiling of \$800,000 per year for the Legislative Bureau.

Substitutes a budget of at least \$2 million, to be increased each year by the composite price index.

Provides that dues for representation of the legislature in regional and international organizations is excluded from the budget.

Provides that the Director of the Legislative Bureau shall submit an itemized budget each year no later than September 1 for adoption by the Legislature by joint resolution.
