

Delegate Proposal No. 133

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes the ceiling of \$800,000 per year for the Legislative Bureau.

Substitutes a budget of <u>at least</u> \$2 million, to be increased each year by the composite price index.

Provides that dues for representation of the legislature in regional and international organizations is <u>excluded</u> from the budget.

Provides that the Director of the Legislative Bureau shall submit an itemized budget each year no later than September 1 for adoption by the Legislature by joint resolution.
