

Delegate Proposal No. 177

Date: May 15, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that gambling is prohibited, unless individual senatorial districts approve it. Gambling may not be imposed by the Legislature on a Commonwealth-wide basis.

Provides that individual senatorial districts may approve gambling only by popular initiative. (Under the current constitution, this would require a 2/3 vote within the senatorial district.)
