



Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 166

Date: May 17, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Adds a provision with respect to the Governor's veto power that permits a third option: the Governor may sign the bill, veto the bill, or return the bill to the Legislature with amendments. If the Legislature enacts the amendments proposed by the Governor, then the Governor is committed to sign the bill and may not veto it.
