DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 351


DATE: May 19, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the definition of a person of Northern Marianas descent from 25% to 6.25% Northern Marianas Chamorro or Northern Marianas Carolinian blood or a combination thereof.

[Note: this would protect two more generations and leave the question whether the definition should be diluted further to the next constitutional convention.]
