

## Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 393

DATE: May 23, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides real local government to the people, the mayors, and the municipal councils of all three major islands by defining areas in which the mayors and municipal councils can act, and leaving the administration and enforcement of Commonwealth law to the Commonwealth government.
