

Delegate Proposal No. 236

Date: May 25, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Requires the Governor to submit a balanced budget by April 30 of each year for the following fiscal year.

Requires the balanced budget to include a plan to retire any deficits incurred during the previous fiscal year.

Provides that if a balanced budget is not approved before the first day of the fiscal year,

- (1) appropriations for public education, public health, and public safety shall continue at the level of the previous fiscal year
- (2) all other appropriations shall be at a level that is 25% of the previous fiscal year
