It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes the language added by the 1985 Constitutional Convention to the provision requiring taxation only for a public purpose, which requires the legislature to define public purpose. The legislature has this power in any event, and this language is not needed in the constitution.
