



Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 256
Date: May 25, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Reinstates the Marianas Public Land Corporation to manage and dispose of the public lands.

Provides for a five-member elected Board of Directors

- one member elected at large from Tinian
- one member elected at large from Rota
- three members elected at large from Saipan

Provides for a four-year term for directors.

Provides for a limit of two terms (eight years).

Provides for the following qualifications for directors:

- the maximum residence requirement permissible under the U.S. Constitution for this kind of position
- each director must be a U.S. citizen
