Delegate Proposal No. 265

May 25, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides for qualifications required of School Board members:

- a Master's Degree in education or five years' experience in some field of education
- the maximum residence requirement permitted for this kind of office under the U.S. Constitution
- domicile in the Commonwealth during service on the Board

Deletes the provision that allows the legislature to change the residence and domicile requirements.
