Delegate Proposal No. 267

May 25, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that Saipan has a true local government including:

- 1. The right to levy local taxes and collect revenues.
- 2. The right to spend revenues from local taxes and other fees imposed by the Saipan local government.
- 3. The authority to act on issues that are strictly local in nature.

Deletes the authority of the Legislature to pass local laws.
