Delegate Proposal No. 267

May 25, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that Saipan has a true local government including:

1. The right to levy local taxes and collect revenues.
2. The right to spend revenues from local taxes and other fees imposed by the Saipan local government.
3. The authority to act on issues that are strictly local in nature.

Deletes the authority of the Legislature to pass local laws.
