

DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 362

DATE: May 26, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Establishes a Revenue Council, as follows --

- 1. The Revenue Council shall have the responsibility of preparing estimates of CNMI revenue.
- 2. The estimates shall be submitted to the Governor and the Legislature at least six months prior to the start of the fiscal year, and shall be made public.
- 3. The Governor must use the revenue estimates in preparing his balanced budget, or provide a written report in the event he exceeds the estimates.
- 4. The Legislature must use the revenue estimates in enacting appropriations and revenue bills, and shall provide a written report in the event their proposed appropriations exceed the estimates.
