Provides for expanded executive and legislative functions in local government:

(1) Executive power in a municipality is exercised by the Mayor. It includes:

- . enforcement of all local laws and ordinances
- . community and cultural affairs
- . business and commerce (under standardized guidelines developed by the Commonwealth Executive Branch)
- . appointment of municipal department heads, created by municipal ordinances
- . developing the municipal budget
- . island beautification
- . environmental protection
- (2) The Mayor is elected on a non-partisan basis.

(3) Legislative power in a municipality is exercised by the Municipal Council. It includes:

- . enacting local laws and ordinances
- confirming the appointment of municipal department heads
- . approving the municipal budget
- (4) The Municipal Council is increased from 3 to 5 members

(5) Municipal Council members are full time and salaried, but their salaries must be paid from revenues generated by the municipality.
