Delegate Proposal No. 300

Date: May 30, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that executive orders issued by the Governor do not reach the autonomous agencies. The personnel, funding and reorganization of the autonomous agencies can be accomplished only by legislation.

Nullifies Executive Order 94-3 and restores the affected agencies by requiring the Governor to appoint new boards and commissions, based on the original enabling legislation, within 90n days.

Provides that in order for any executive order to affect existing law, it must be passed by a majority vote of both houses of the legislature. Otherwise such an executive order is void.
