Date: May 30, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that an operating deficit must be liquidated within two fiscal years, following the year in which the deficit occurred.

Defines operating deficit to include funds the government used that should have been transferred to autonomous agencies, including earmarked revenues and appropriations for the autonomous agencies.
