Delegate Proposal No. 305

Date: June 1, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Reduces the size of the Senate to six members:

- two from Rota
- two from Tinian and Aguiguan
- two from Saipan and the Northern Islands

Provides that the Lieutenant Governor serves as the President Pro Tem of the Senate. The Lieutenant Governor may vote only in case of a tie.
