

Delegate Proposal No. 218

Date: June 2, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the Mayor has responsibility for the execution of Commonwealth laws and the administration of public services in the municipality in which the Mayor has been elected.

Provides that public services being provided by the Commonwealth on a decentralized basis as of January 7, 1986 must continue on a decentralized basis.

Provides that the mayor shall have the responsibility of ensuring that the resident department heads faithfully execute their duties under the laws and in accordance with the policies of the Commonwealth government for the administration of public services within the municipality.

Provides that the Mayor shall have the exclusive right to discipline or dismiss resident department heads delivering decentralized public services within the municipality.
