

Delegate Proposal No. 227

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Delete the provision that directs the legislature to provide criteria for domicile and residence, as the legislature has already done this.

Add a provision that requires any person who lives in any senatorial district for one year to vote in that senatorial district.

CONSTITUTIONAL ARTICLES THAT WOULD BE AMENDED: Art. VII, Sec. 3

CONSTITUTIONAL ARTICLES THAT WOULD BE AFFECTED: Art. II, Sec. 2(d), Art. II, Sec. 3(d) (both of which require candidates for the legislature to be registered voters in the district where they are a candidate)
