

Delegate Proposal No. 230

Date: June 2, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the provision with respect to compensation of legislators from an annual salary to compensation based on the number of sessions attended.

(Note: Changes in compensation would remain as in the present constitution, by an advisory commission)

Deletes the limitations on sessions of the legislature and provides that each house shall meet in regular sessions as provided by its rules, and may be convened at other times by its presiding officer or the governor.
