ISLAND ORDER NO. 23-46:

Subject: Electrical power, requirements for.

1. An Island Power System is now being constructed. In order that the distribution system may be constructed and transformers and cable of the proper size installed where required, it is necessary to know the location, type and amount of all electric loads.

2. Load checks have been made on all existing installations and show present conditions. In order that island power may be properly controlled and distributed, it is directed that all activities on Saipan make request for any proposed changes in location of existing installations requiring power and also for all new installations requiring power, to the Island Commander, (Attention Public Works Officer) prior to making the change or starting the new construction. The Island Commander will advise whether the changes proposed can be met by the Island Power System.
