1. Certain phases of the operations of the Asian Refugee Foundation, Inc., involve procedures of a classified nature. The disclosure to the Manager of classified information relevant to the operation of the Asian Refugee Foundation, Inc., is at times necessary. The personnel operating the Foundation are American citizens who have been carefully screened.
2. CIVAD Saipan is hereby authorized to make available to Mr. L. W. Duke, Manager of the Asian Refugee Foundation, Inc., classified information including Top Secret which, in the opinion of CIVAD Saipan, should be made available for the proper functioning of the Foundation.
3. Transmission by United States registered mail or registered guard mail is authorized in accordance with article 7-5, United States Navy Security Manual for Classified Matter.

1. The communications specialists; A. G. Emmett, Jr. and P. S. Chadwick, Jr., were sent to Saipan as a result of the request contained in enclosure (1).

2. Enclosure (1) was purposely written in non-classified form. The background for this request is that Colonel Cushman, USMC, who is interested in the Asian Refugee Foundation, Inc., requested DERNICOMTERPACIS to arrange for some civilian communications specialists to be sent to Saipan to handle the communications for ARFI. The plan was that the civil service men sent there would encrypt, decrypt, transmit and receive ARFI traffic using the CIVAD radio facilities. There is a possibility that eventually ARFI will have its own radio station but at present they are authorized to use the CIVAD radio equipment.

3. LT C. J. CAREY, USNR, who was on Saipan 17 January 1951, reported that Mr. Duke of ARFI was not aware at that time of the status of these men. Possibly he has received some information regarding them since that time from his home office.

4. As indicated in reference (c) it is desired that CIVAD Saipan contact the manager of Asian Refugee Foundation, Inc., and work out details for the employment of these men. The Chief of Naval Operations advises that both Emmett and Chadwick are cleared for top secret. CIVAD Saipan is further advised that although Emmett and Chadwick have adequate clearance for their own purposes they are not to have access to the classified files and dispatches of the CIVAD.

1. Upon receipt of reference (b), a conference was held with the general manager of ARFI and a mutually agreeable arrangement was effected regarding the employment of Mr. Emmett and Mr. Chadwick. Under this agreement Mr. Chadwick and Mr. Emmett divide their time between watches on Civil Administration circuits and crypto work for ARFI. The general manager of ARFI is providing stowage and working space within the limits of the ARFI camp for the processing of ARFI's encrypted traffic.

2. Since a mutually agreeable system had already been set up prior to the receipt of reference (a), no action other than advising the general manager, ARFI of the contents of reference (a) was deemed necessary upon the receipt of reference (a).
