1. Reference (a) requested all necessary action be taken to obtain required land data, including surveys, property descriptions and maps covering revised Air Force needs on Saipan and Tinian as outlined in enclosure (1) of reference (a). It further requested a delimitation and description of those areas presently used or occupied by the District Administrator, Government of the Trust Territory, for governmental or administrative purposes and those areas presently settled by the inhabitants or used and occupied in the native economy on Tinian.

2. Reference (b) directed COMNAVMAIANAS to revise Saipan drawings, previously submitted, by excepting therefrom areas 5, 6 and 7; to revise index and furnish revised maps and index as requested by reference (a).

3. In accordance with the requests of references (a) and (b), this Command has caused new boundary surveys to be made on Saipan and Tinian and enclosure (1) herewith is forwarded as the desired information:

a. Drawing No. 10010 (revised 4-25-52) is corrected Key Map of Saipan excepting former areas 5, 6 and 7, but including additional areas described in paragraph 2(a), enclosure (1) of reference (a).

b. Drawings Nos. 10050, 10099 and 10060 are maps of the individual areas requested for retention by paragraph 2(a), enclosure (1) of reference (a).

c. Drawing No. 10067 is boundary map of entire Island of Tinian, designated as the Air Force requirement by paragraph 2(b), enclosure (2) of reference (a).

d. Drawing No. 10069 is map designating those areas on Tinian which are presently utilized for administration by the District Administrator (Trust

territory) and homestead sites by indigines for agricultural and industrial purposes.

3. Drawing No. 10964 is now designating a proposed site for the relocation of San Jose Village, Tinian.

4. The information delineated upon items d and e above was furnished this Command by the District Administrator, Saipan which is a part of the program in the Saipan District for the development of the native economy.
