GENERAL ORDER NO. 1-44

Subject: Civilians in Protective Custody - Restriction of Movement of.

1. Notice is hereby given that Japanese and Koreans of the Civilian camp are forbidden to be or to pass outside the camp for any purpose unless accompanied by an American guard. The boundaries of the camp are marked by wire fencing.

2. Notice is hereby given that Japanese and Koreans of the civilian camp are forbidden to be in or to enter any area occupied by American personnel without permission.

3. Persons who violate this order will be subject to punishment as provided by Proclamation No. 2 and Proclamation No. 3 of the Military Governor. These proclamations are posted in the camp.
