TO THE PEOPLE OF TINIAN:

The following sanitary regulations will be strictly observed by all civilians living in Camp Churo:

- 1. WATER. The basic requirements for each shelter will be:
 - (a) Water Drums.

 - (6) If oil is placed in the drums by the Sanitary Detail, this oil is not to be skimmed off, poured out, nor removed in any way. (b) Water Cans.
 - - (1) Only metal water cans will be used.
 - (2) Not more than two (2) water cans will be used by one family. Each can may be of five (5) gallon capacity.
 - (3) These water cans will be used only for transporting cistern water. Only one of these water cans will be used by each family as a container for drinking water.
 - (c) Wash Trays.
 - (1) Only one wash tray, or the equivalent thereof, will be allowed to each family for washing clothes and dishes.

 - (a) No garbage, cans, or trash are permitted to accumulate in or around the shelters. Such garbage, cans, and trash are to be put in the barrels provided for that purpose.
