MEMORANDUM NO. 34-45

From: Public Safety - Intelligence Officer.
To : All Civilian Police Departments.
Subject: Procedure in handling materials confiscated at gates.

1. The following procedure is outlined to eliminate non-uniformity in the handling of articles confiscated from civilians at gates:

(a) Where the persons, from whom articles are taken, are placed under arrest, materials shall be turned over to the Police Department which is booking the person arrested at the time the arrest report is made out. Such materials shall be forwarded with the arrest report to the Public Safety Officer.

(b) Where material is confiscated and no arrest is made, material shall be placed in boxes located at gates. Area Commanders are responsible for delivery of such materials to the salvage hut located in the Administrative Area.

2. This memorandum shall be translated into Chamorro, Japanese and Korean languages and shall be the subject of a special lecture to all Policemen prior to 13 September 1946. Notify Public Safety - Intelligence Officer of date and time of lecture.
