MEMORANDUM NO. 35-45

From: Public Safety - Intelligence Officer.
To : All Civilian Police Departments.
Subject: Trucks driven by civilians - search of.

1. All trucks driven by civilians (natives, Japanese, or Korean) shall be carefully checked when both entering and leaving areas #1, 2, or 3 at all times. Any articles, such as food, clothing, handicraft, etc., carried by these trucks shall be confiscated and all occupants of truck detained for questioning, unless trucks carrying such materials are assigned specifically to the duty of carrying articles otherwise forbidden.

2. Arrest reports shall be made on such persons and forwarded to Public Safety Department along with articles seized, as evidence.

3. This order shall be translated into the Chamorro, Korean, and Japanese languages and be the subject of special lectures to all police not later than Thursday, 20 September 1945. Notify Public Safety Officer of time and date of lectures.
