Reference: Reference (a) states that "No labor will be employed until approved by the Military Government Labor Department". There have been cases reported where natives have left their regular employment in order to go to work for private American Military personnel. In the future, all rprivate employment during the regular working day must

be approved by Military Government.

There is no objection to natives accepting work for private persons after the regular working hours. The rate of pay for this work will not exceed one and one half times the regular wage.
