MILITARY GOVERNMENT ORDER 1-47

To the Natives of Saipan.

1. Naval regulations forbid the sale of supplies from the Naval Supply Center directly to civilians. The government has therefore authorized the United States Commercial Company (USCC) to be the agent for the Chamorros on Saipan in purchasing necessary supplies.

2. It is therefore directed that no Guamanian, Chamorro or Carolinian will buy or attempt to buy any foodstuffs or other supplies from the Naval Supply Center without first making necessary arrangements with the USCC. This also applies to any privately operated business.
