JOINT LETTER

Messrs. E. T. Calvo and F. C. Torres,
doing business as Marianas Trading and
Steamship Company,
Agana, Guam.

Dear Sirs:

Recent conference with your representatives indicates that you are unwilling to develop a fixed schedule of sailings (weather permitting), which it was stated in our joint letter of 23 July 1948, was desired as soon as practicable. Furthermore at this conference, one of your representatives freely admitted that your ship had failed to stop at Tinian on a recent trip, and further that your line was not interested in carrying produce from Tinian.

Your attention is invited to the fact that your temporary permit, granted on a revocable basis, expressly states that " - - - at least one round trip from Guam to Saipan will be made every other week, stopping at Tinian southbound each trip - - -, weather permitting".

You are requested to inform us of your intentions in regard to developing and maintaining schedules including making stops at Tinian. A reply by 5 October, 1948 will be appreciated.
