- 1. Ambassador Francis B. Sayre will visit the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands during May, 1949 for familiarization purposes in connection with his duties as United States Representative on the Trusteeship Council of the United Nations. His visit is being made at this time in preparation for the examination by the Trusteeship Council in late June of this year of the 1948 Trust Territory report to the United Nations. He will be accompanied on his trip through the Trust Territory by his assistant, Mr. William Yeemans and by Commander Lee M. Duke of the Office of Island Governments.
- 2. By references (a) and (b) an itinerary for Ambassader Sayre's trip through the Trust Territory was agreed to. In amplification of the itinerary, enclosure (A) is ferwarded. Rigid adherence to this itinerary is not necessary. It is expected that some minor changes will be made as required to meet local recommendations on places to visit and transportation availabilities.

3. Ambassador Sayre was designated by the President as United States Representative on the Trusteeship Council in January, 1947. A brief of his prefessional background is contained in enclosure (B). Ambassador Sayre has requested that his visit be considered informal and that no ceremenies aside from usual courtesies be planned.

## BRIEF OF AMBASSADOR SAYRE'S PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Prior to 1923 taught Government and Law at Harvard and University of Southern California. Appointed special advisor to Siamese Government, 1923-25. Became Director, Harvard Institute of Criminal Law, 1929-34.

Became Assistant Secretary of State (appointed by President Franklin D. Roosevelt), 1933-39, in charge of negotiations of American trade agreements with other countries. Chairman of Executive Commission on Commercial Policy for U. S. Government, 1933-39. Chairman, U. S. Interdepartmental Committee on Philippines, 1934-39. U. S. High Commissioner for Philippines, 1939-42. Escaped from Corregidor by submarine in February 1942. Special Assistant to Secretary of State and Departmental Director of Foreign Relief and Rehabilitation operations, 1943, Head of UNRRA delegation to Iraq, 1945. Decorated by many foreign governments. Became U.S. advisor on Trusteeship Council upon dissolution of UNRRA.
