Information for Persons Desiring to
Visit the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands

Persons wishing to visit the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands should address their requests for entry visas to the High Commissioner, 3845 Kilauea Avenue, Honolulu 16, Hawaii. First requests should include the following information:

1. Full name and home address of applicant.
2. Purpose of visit. If on business, state nature of business and name and address of employer.
3. Areas to be visited in the Trust Territory. In general, the areas open to alien (including American) visitors are those immediately surrounding the six District Administration Headquarters located at Majuro in the Marshall Islands; Ponape, Truk (Moen Island), Koror and Yap in the Carolines; and Saipan in the Marianas. Visits to the outer islands may be made in exceptional cases by special arrangement where approval can be obtained from the local authorities. This restriction is necessary as no provisions exist for caring for visitors outside the administrative centers.
4. Approximate date of departure.
5. Proposed length of stay in each area.
6. Means of transportation (air or surface) to be employed.
7. Whether the applicant has made a previous visit to the Trust Territory and if so, the dates.

In addition to an entry visa, visitors will be required to have in their possession:

1. A valid passport, and in the case of non-Americans, a valid re-entry permit or visa authorizing further travel.
2. Evidence of inoculation within one (1) year against smallpox, tetanus, and typhoid, and a certificate of freedom from communicable disease.
3. Evidence of financial responsibility to the extent that the proposed visit will be completed at no cost to the Trust Territory Government. (Return ticket, fare, or equivalent).
4. Security clearance issued by the United States Navy to visit the areas proposed. Security clearance should be arranged by the applicant by addressing the Naval Command listed below located nearest the place of business of the applicant:

The Trust Territory is entered via Guam which is served by commercial airlines and steamship service. Travel within the Territory is by Transocean Airlines and Pacific Micronesian Steamship Lines, both of which services originate from Guam and call regularly at each of the District Headquarters. The business address, fares, and schedules of each are attached for convenience of prospective travellers. Travel arrangements must be effected between the traveller and the carrier and are subject to the prior needs of government business.

Living accommodations at District Headquarters may be arranged through the High Commissioner's office and are subject to the prior needs of the administration. Normally, about one week is required to obtain confirmation of the availability of accommodations.
