
My dear Captain Winfrey:

There are attached copies of cables sent by the United Nations Technical Assistance Administration to Mr. Olympic Borja of Saipan and to the Director of Education of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands concerning the scholarship award to Mr. Borja.

As you know, we have been informed today by the United States Mission to the United Nations that Mr. Borja must leave Saipan immediately in order to arrive in Australia by April 3 when the term begins at Sydney University.

I hope that the Government of the Trust Territory will be able to finance the transportation costs to enable Mr. Borja to take up this scholarship.
