My dear Mr. Unayana

Your letter deted 2 May and marked for delivery by hand was received by me on 3 May lete in the aftermoon.

As you knee, the question of the illegal imprisonment and maltrestment of Luis D. Nise by the delipases constabulary is being investing and today by Commander Avila of my staff, someompanied by Vice Gonsul Yango and Nise. The presence of Vice Consul Yango and Nise is desired as is relevant evidence which the aggricved party may be able to produce. You may be assured that should your charges be proved, action will be taken against the guilty parties.

In the meantime, I believe it behooves both of us to maintain the good relations between us. The publicity given this case is considered premature and therefore unfortunate.
