Subj: Trust Territory real estate; continuing need for

1. The Land shown on reference (a) is property of the Government of the Trust Territory. There are approximately 69 acres contained in the camp site. This land was utilized and quonset buildings erected by the contractor, contract Noy 13931, Yards and Docks project 324. Construction under that project has terminated. Reference (b) recommended that the improvements, fixtures, and utilities revert to the Government of the Trust Territory upon completion of the project without cost to the Government of the Trust Territory.
2. The Naval Administrator has determined that in view of the forthcoming replacement housing and other projects that there will be a continuing need for the BPM camp site and the Class 2 and 3 plant account property located thereon.
3. In the interest of good administration the Navy's need to continue the use of the subject area and the property located thereon should be formalized in writing.
4. It is requested that the Government of the Trust Territory execute the necessary documents for an indefinite use of this property at no charge to the U. S. Government.
