Dear Commander Miller,

I am enclosing for your files a copy of a report as to the status of royalties under our contract with the Navy at Saipan.

Two copies of this have been transmitted to the Commander in Chief, United States Pacific Fleet, and one copy has been sent to the Naval Administrator, Saipan.

We have sent to the Naval Administrator, Saipan, several days ago, complete information as to each individual transaction for 1957 and 1958, including copies of bills of lading, final invoices, outturn weight certificates and individual reports of each sale, analyzing the details. Since all of this information is incorporated into the report which I am sending to you today, I am not having the individual reports duplicated unless you should request it.

I also enclose a copy of a letter written today to Mr. Nucker, who was forced to break today's appointments and who departed early for Guam. This letter spells out what I would think could be the only procedures that we may follow at this point, and I would think would form the basis for discussions in Honolulu with the staff of the Commander in Chief, United States Fleet.

Accordingly, I have written to the Commander in Chief, United States Fleet, and have requested a conference on this matter. I have separately sent him a copy of this letter to the High Commissioner.
