Steeves took up matter of Trust Territory claims with Nicht yesterday, along lines Deptel 2216, with emphasis on ex gratia payment on basis moral obligation of Japan to compensate Trust Territories inhabitants. Steeves referred to good will which had accrued from Japanese reparations payments in Southeast Asia; mentioned marking from Japanese reparations payments in Southeast Asia; mentioned marking from Japanese reparations and possible moral obligation noted fareautiful last year's Tokyo press report/marking reftel; and expressed hope Japanese Government would give matter mentioned careful consideration. Nishiyama said he would report to Foreign Office but expressed personal opinion that it would be extremely difficult to ask Diet recognize payment outside Article 4(a). He specifically asked if ex gratia payment would be outside Article 4(a) settlement and was informed that it would be.

Embassy should make similar approach to Foreign Office emphasizing that main purpose of settlement at this time is to solve problem arising as result Trusteeship Council visiting mission's report. Embassy might stress good will which would be likely accrue for Japan in UN and among inhabitants
