## MENORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Transfer of Responsibility for Administration of Subji Saipan District from the Mavy Department to the Interior Department (U)

Ref:

(a) SECIMTERIOR ltr of 9 Jun 1961 to SECNAY

b) SECHAY 1tr Ser 277709B2 of 20 Jun 1961 to SECIMTERIOR

(e) ASTSECIMTERIOR 1tr of 12 July 1961 to SECHAY

1. References (a), (b) and (c) concern a proposal from the Secretary of Interior to transfer the responsibility for the administration of the Saipen District, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands from the Department of the Mavy to the Department of the Interior.

2. The two Secretaries having agreed in principle to the transfer, a meeting was held this date to fermulate plans and procedures to effect an orderly transfer of administration on or about 1 July 1962. The following representatives of the Navy and Interior Departments attended:

- 3. Interior led off the discussion with some questions pertaining to the expected tenure of MITTO on Saipan and logistic support required. Interior was advised that the proposed transfer had been discussed with the agency spensoring WITT and the Aponey had informed the Nevy they did not have any ourrent plans for withdrawing operations from Saipan. Interior was informed of legistic support arrangements provided WIII through their own vessel the FOUR VINDS and their own sirereft.
- 4. At the Mayy's suggestion Interior agreed to prepare the necessary Executive Order cancelling Executive Orders 10470 and 10408 covering the present mavel administration of Seipan and the transfer of this responsibility to the Secretary of Interior.

- 5. Interior impaired as to wester they would be able to place a District Administrator and certain staff members for Saipan on Navy rells for a short period prior to the actual transfer on 1 July 1962, in order to provide a smooth turnover of administration. They were advised in the affirmative.
- 6. Deterior was advised that the turnover of administrative responsibility would follow the pattern proviously established in 1950-51 and 1952 severing prior transfers between the Nevy and Interior. This would include a general transfer of all facilities and equipment on a non-reintersable basis.
- To helative to bedgetting for FT 1963 operations of the Nevel Administration Dait Salpan, Interior was advised that this had already gone forward in the Nevy's budget for FT 1963. Withoute disposition of those funds would require a decision by the Bareau of the Budget.
- 8. Interior requested that ammonstant of the proposed bransfer to the field commands concerned be withheld temperarily, pending further discussions by their representatives with ASTSECINTERIOR John A. Carver. It was so agreed.
