## MENORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Subj: Transfer of Responsibility for Administration of Saipan District from the Mavy Department to the Interior Department (U)

(a) SECINTERIOR ltr of 9 Jun 1961 to SECNAY Reft

(b) SECNAV 1tr Ser 277P09B2 of 20 Jun 1961 to SECINTERIOR

(e) ASTSECIMTERIOR 1tr of 12 July 1961 to SECNAY

1. References (a), (b) and (c) concern a proposal free the Secretary of Interior to transfer the responsibility for the administration of the Saipan District, Trust Territory of the Posific Islands from the Department of the Navy to the Departsent of the Interior.

2. The two Secretaries having agreed in principle to the transfer, a meeting was held this date to fermulate plans and procedures to effect an orderly transfer of administra-tion on or about 1 July 1962. The following representatives of the Navy and Interior Departments absended:

- 3. Interior led off the discussion with some questions pertaining to the expected temmre of NTTU on Salpan and logistic support required. Interior was advised that the proposed transfer had been discussed with the agency spensoring WITU and the Agency had informed the Mavy they did not have any current plans for withdrawing operations from Saipan. Interior was informed of legistic support arrangements provided MTTS through their own vessel the FOUR VINDS and their own aircraft.
- 4. At the Mavy's suggestion Interior agreed to prepare the necessary Executive Order cancelling Executive Orders 10470 and 10408 covering the present naval administration of Salpan and the transfer of this responsibility to the Secretary of Interior.

- 6. Interior was advised that the terrover of administrative responsibility would follow the pattern proviously established in 1950-51 and 1952 covering prior transfers between the May and Interior. This would include a general transfer of all facilities and equipment on a non-relaborable backs.
- 7. Relative to bedgeting for FY 1963 operations of the Maval Administration Unit Saipan, Interior was advised that this had already goes forward in the Mavy's budget for FY 1963. Ultimate disposition of these funds would require a decision by the Bureau of the Budget.
- 8. Interior requested that announcement of the prepased breasfer to the field commands concerned be withheld temperarily, pending further discussions by their representatives with ASTRECIPTERICR John A. Carver. It was so agreed.
