Enclosed for your review and comments are copies of a draft executive order transferring the Saipan District of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to the Secretary of the Interior.

We appreciate that the executive order will be supported by a Nevy-Interior agreement and we hope that Admiral Coye and High Commissioner Coding will soon be able to work out the basics of such an agreement. However, we feel that the executive order should be kept as simple as possible and should be forwarded for signature as soon as possible. Hence, we have prepared a draft which revokes Executive Orders Numbered 10408 and 10470 and extends again to the Sairan District the provisions of Executive Order No. 10265.
