SUBJECT: Transfer of Property, NAVAD and WTRC surplus.

1. I concur with Mr. Baker's comment that the transfer agreement should be written in broad terms so that title to all real property is to be transferred to Dept. of Interior. Upon receipt of the transfer document, DIRPAC DOCKS could forward the property record cards on file to PT Hueneine as disposition, to remove this property from the Navy Inventory. By this action, the Dept. of Interior acquires:

all property, whether on Navy Inventory records or not. I cannot see any advantages to conducting an inventory, updating inventory property record cards and then disposing the property by transfer to Dept. of Interior. A caveat however contingent upon transfer agreement being in broad terms with no detailed property inventory listings.

2. I believe the proposed action as written by Mr. Baker is similar to transfer of American Samoa property.
